aim of the subject

- 1) Learning how to write a scientific article and compile a scientific conference presentation;
- 2) Developing both oral and written self-expression and communication skills in a foreign-language scientific environment;
- 3) Developing skills for working with foreign-language scientific literature;
- 4) Developing, analysing and synthesising skills in analysing texts and the application of these skills in compiling a scientific presentation or article;
- 5) Learning how to make a scientific presentation, using the respective technical means.

content

Students will learn how to write a scientific article and compile and present a scientific conference presentation. For that purpose, articles on educational science written in Estonian and foreign languages are analysed. Students will develop and improve their presentation and self-expression skills. The course includes participation in a scientific conference.

learning outcomes

After completing the subject, students will:

- 1) be able to create a competent scientific text which contributes to international scientific research, and to format it correctly;
- 2) know how to compile a scientific presentation and also present it electronically;
- 3) have acquired basic experience in scientific discussions, following the most important principles of research ethics;
- 4) have the necessary communication and self-expression skills;
- 5) be able to work with literature in foreign languages;
- 6) have analysing and synthesising skills in working with scientific texts and be able to apply these skills in compiling a presentation or a scientific article.

assessment

To obtain a positive assessment result, students are required to:

- 1) actively participate in all lectures and seminars;
- 2) compile an oral scientific presentation and present it at a conference in Estonia, if possible;
- 3) write one scientific article on a topic related to their dissertation.

assessment criteria

Positive assessment result is obtained when the student has compiled the presentation and the written article meets the requirements set out in the learning outcomes of the subject.
